Dear Sport,

As you may be aware, the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) has released the 2007 Prohibited List (the *2007 List*) which comes into effect January 1, 2007.

The 2007 List, Summary of Modifications for 2007 and the 2007 Monitoring Program are available for download on the WADA website (www.wada-ama.org). A link to the *2007 List* is also available on the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) website (www.asada.gov.au).

Attached is a summary of the key modifications to the *2007 List*, and a list outlining the status of glucocorticosteroids according to the route of administration.

ASADA advises all athletes to review the status of all medications and substances each year in accordance with the updated Prohibited List.
