- Implementing New South Wales's component of the National Talent Identification (NTID) program. (An ASC RA initiative to identify and subsequently fast track the development of potential elite athletes to an Olympic and world championship level of competition)
- Coordination of NSW representative teams.
- Development initiatives to establish more effective pathways from school rowing to club rowing programs.
- Coordination of Rowing New South Wales's coach education and development programs.
- Assist the CEO with special events and other activities.
