GUIDELINES FOR APPLYING TO REGISTER COLOURS

The Association is endeavouring to eliminate the conflict of racing colours, and the resulting misidentification of clubs and schools at regattas.

You can assist by ensuring that your crews are correctly attired and that all oars and sculls comply with the colours approved by the N.S.W.RA. as required by the Laws of Boat Racing.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. TICK the appropriate boxes, providing an accurate description and submit three (3) copies to the NSWRA, P.O. Box 722, Glebe, 2037.
2. The front and back of the singlet are to be of the same design except for the addition of a club or school crest.
3. To enable uniform description of colour shades in blue and green, the colour selection is to be made from the following Derwent Artists coloured pencils :-

BLUE

- # 34 Sky Blue (Sky)
- # 33 Light Blue (Light)
- # 29 Ultra Marine (Royal)
- # 35 Prussian Blue (Navy)

GREEN

- # 44 Water Green (Light)
- # 41 Jade Green (Medium)
- # 45 Mineral Green (Dark)

4. So that your club / school colours are conspicuously displayed, it is suggested that the minimum size of 3 cm for trim cm 5cm for hoops, bands, stripes and sashes be used.
5. The size and spacing of all stripes, bands or sashes in blade design are to be indicated.
6. All sculling, cleaver and spoon type blade colour designs are to be identical, irrespective of the type used.
7. Should a school be rowing from a club or college facility and using their equipment, the name of the host facility is to be indicated in the coloured blade section.
8. String type singlet backs are not suitable as colours cannot be seen.
9. Plain white blades are not acceptable.
