

2007 INTERSTATE REGATTA STATE OF ORIGIN RULES

Dear All State Rowing Associations,

With the year rapidly coming to a close and many athletes considering selection for the 2007 Interstate Regatta, it is a good time to remind all State Rowing Associations of the change to the State or Origin Rules.

As per the Rowing Australia Rules 2006 Edition published on the 10th of February 2006 and currently posted on the Rowing Australia website, rule 6.3 identifies the process for an athlete to apply to compete for their state of domicile. Please note that in these rules the date in which an application needs to be lodged with Rowing Australia has changed from previous years. ***All written applications must be received by the Board of Rowing Australia by the close of business on the 30th of November in the year prior to competition.***

Attached is an application form that can be used to apply for an Interstate Transfer. In order to assist with any applications it would also be greatly appreciated if an athlete applying for a transfer can provide evidence of their registration with State Rowing Association they are wishing to race for.
