### *IT'S A WHOPPER!*

Thank you to all of those who have entered the 2007 Australian Masters Rowing Championships at the Sydney International Regatta Centre, Penrith

The competition will commence, as planned, on Friday, 1 June and conclude on Sunday, 3 June, 2007.

We have in excess of 1,560 boats - 1,100 competitors and almost 5,500 seats

To help up tidy up the program and ensure your entries are correct we'd appreciate you checking through your entries and advise us of any inaccuracies by no later than 5.00 pm on Sunday, 20 May.

We've found problems in the following areas –

- Some crews are entered into events for which they are not eligible, i.e, they appear to have entered “up” a grade or two – it could be there's an error in a DOB – or you may have a wrong competitor in the boat.
- Some crews have crew members missing – please supply names and DOB – currently your crews are classified A.
- The names of coxswains are missing in many places.
- There appear to be a couple of duplicated entries.

If we are unable to resolve these anomalies by Sunday night, your crew will be moved to the A category event or removed from the entry list altogether. Over to you.

The regatta will be conducted according to the rules and laws of boat racing of Rowing Australia Inc.

## ***Race List***

We have also put together an indicative race list based on the entries received. This will give you an indication of when you'll be racing. There may be slight changes to this list depending on the outcome of our enquiries: we hope to confirm the timetable early next week. [Click here](#) for the provisional race list.

Note: If heats are consolidated to a straight final as a result of withdrawals, the final will be rowed at the published time of the final and the time slots for the heats left vacant.

The draw will be conducted according to the rules of Rowing Australia and will be published at the earliest possible time.

## ***The Way to the Finals***

We've made a slight change to the progression to final for the 37+ entry category – the first 4 competitors in each of each of 6 heats will progress to the semi finals and 3 competitors from each of the 3 semi-finals will proceed to the final. To confirm -

1-9 entries	1 Final
10-18 entries	2 heats, first 4 to Final
19-27 entries	3 heats, first 3 to Final
28-36 entries	4 heats, first 2 to Final
37-54 entries	6 heats, first 4 to Semi Final, 3 Semi Finals, first 3 to Final
