CALL FOR ENTRIES

The Head of the Clarence River Committee extends a warm invitation to clubs and schools to participate in this premier school student event. The regatta will be rowed on the Grafton Rowing Club course: the regatta will commence at 8.30 am with heats of those Championship events where the entry level exceeds the extent of the course (8 crews).

Other, non-championship, events will be rowed as Divisions. Finals and divisions of events will be rowed in the order as listed herewith.

Eligibility to Enter

Entry into the regatta is open to any bona fide school student who is registered with the NSWRA or their respective State rowing association.

Age Definitions:

An Under 15 competitor is one who reaches the age of 14 by 31 December, 2009.

An Under 17 competitor is one who reaches the age of 16 by 31 December, 2009.

Proof of age may be required.

Boats:

All quad sculls are coxed events therefore crews must carry a coxswain or weights to the equivalent minimum weight of a coxswain in their category.

Coxswains:

Coxswain's weights: Schoolboys - minimum of 50 kgs - Schoolgirls - minimum of 45 kgs.

Entries:

Entries can be made on line via the RNSW Rowing Manager system - please check with RNSW if you do not have a password (02 8116 9777) - or via mail to PO Box 265, Concord West, 2138; fax (02 8732 1618) or by hand to Rowing NSW, at Sports House, 6 Figtree Drive, Olympic Park, Homebush.

Entry fees: \$8.00 per seat – Payment is required when lodging entries.

Entries close at 5.00 pm on Wednesday, 2 December, 2009. Late entries will be accepted up until 2.00 pm on Tuesday, 8 December, 2009 provided there is an available lane. Late entries are required to be lodged by mail, fax or by hand and incur payment of the entry fee and a late entry fee.
