Advisory information regarding site access Defqon, September 2017

Sydney International Regatta Centre is hosting the ninth Defqon 1 event in September 2017. As you would understand from previous years there will be a substantial amount of overlay and preparation required prior to the event.

The bump-in for the event will begin on Monday 4th September 2017. All overlay will be removed from the venue by Thursday 21st September 2017.

There will be no opportunity to access the Venue (including walking and cycle paths), Island or boatsheds from Monday 4th – Thursday 21st September inclusive.

Any unforeseen need to access the venue during this time will be assessed on a case by case basis and would need to be arranged with Venue Management directly.

If your access request is approved to proceed to the Venue Management Office, Boat Sheds, Nutrition Station, Sailability or the Lakeside Restaurant, please follow the directions given to you at the Island screening area (outlined on the map on the back of this letter). Parking arrangements on the Island will be very limited and may vary on a day to day basis. Please follow the directions of security staff, traffic marshals and signage.

Access to the Boatsheds will be as normal until Sunday 3rd September 2017 and ***all boat trailers / vehicles and equipment should be removed from the front and back of the boatsheds by this date.***
